ADVOCATING FOR CHANGE: NAAF'S LEGISLATIVE LIAISONS

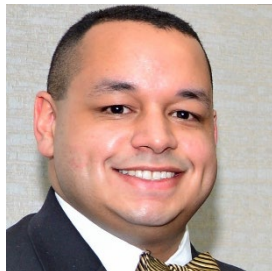
Thursday, May 6, 2021 | 4:00 pm–6:00 pm PT

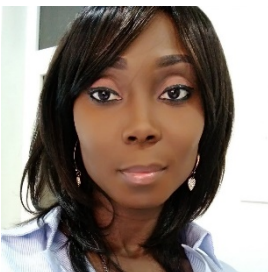

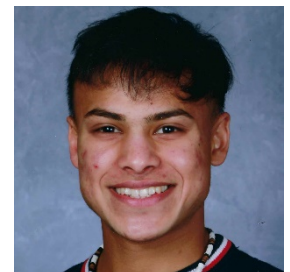
