



2024 Travel Grant Application

- DESCRIPTION** To help early career researchers cover the cost of attending a scientific conference or meeting to present research related to alopecia areata. Meetings of particular interest include: the Society for Investigative Dermatology, American Academy of Dermatology, World Congress of Dermatology, World Congress for Hair Research, and other relevant meetings in immunology, skin, and hair research.
- ELIGIBILITY** Applicant must be a graduate student, postdoctoral fellow, or a newer MD and/or PhD in early-stage career development from an academic research institution. You must have an alopecia areata-related abstract accepted for oral or poster presentation at the meeting and attend the conference in its entirety. Note: the number of travel awards to any one research group or laboratory may be limited to encourage broad participation.
- AWARD AMOUNT** Awards of up to \$1,000 for domestic travel and \$1,500 for international travel are available to qualified applicants.
- TERMS** Travel grants may only be used to cover registration, travel, and accommodation. Individuals may receive no more than one travel grant award per calendar year.
- APPLICATION** Travel Grant applications must be received by NAAF at least 30 days prior to the anticipated meeting to be considered. Exceptions may be made for late-breaking abstract acceptances. Applications must include a copy of the abstract submitted and a copy of the letter or e-mail confirming acceptance of presentation or poster.
